

Alpine Miniatures Painting Retreat Terms and Conditions of Participation

1. Purpose and Scope

These Terms and Conditions govern the participation in the miniature painting week ("the Event") organized by the non-profit association C'est Lavis ("the Organizer"). By registering, participants acknowledge that they have read, understood, and accepted these conditions.

2. Registration and Payment

Registration is confirmed only upon full payment of the participation fee.

Once payment is received, the registration is definitive and non-refundable.

Payments must be made within the deadline indicated in the registration form or confirmation email.

3. Cancellations and Replacements

In case of withdrawal, participants are responsible for finding their own replacement.

Only if the Event is fully booked and has a waiting list, the Organizer may reassign the vacated spot and accept the cancellation without charge.

No refunds or partial reimbursements are provided unless explicitly confirmed in writing by the Organizer.

4. Non-Profit Character and Collective Contribution

This Event is organized on a non-profit basis. Fees are calculated to cover direct costs only.

Participants are expected to contribute to the smooth running of shared activities and logistics outside of workshop hours (e.g., tidying up, helping with communal meals or spaces).

5. Responsibility and Insurance

Participation is at one's own risk and responsibility.

C'est Lavis and its staff decline all liability for accidents, injuries, theft, loss, or damage to personal belongings.

Participants are responsible for their insurance coverage during their stay in Switzerland.

6. Code of Conduct and Charter of Participation

All participants agree to respect the Charter of Participation, which will be displayed on site.

The Organizer reserves the right to exclude any participant whose behavior violates the Charter or who fails to follow the instructions of the organizing team.

No racist, sexist, homophobic, or otherwise discriminatory behavior will be tolerated under any circumstances.

7. Image and Media Consent

Photos and videos may be taken during the Event for internal documentation and public communication (website, social media, reports).

Participants who do not wish to appear in such materials must notify the Organizer in writing before the start of the Event.

8. Force Majeure and Changes

The Organizer reserves the right to modify, postpone, or cancel the Event in case of force majeure (e.g., illness of key instructors, natural disaster, pandemic, or similar events).

In such cases, the Organizer will make reasonable efforts to find an alternative solution but cannot guarantee full reimbursement.

9. Applicable Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms and Conditions are governed by Swiss law.

The place of jurisdiction is Fribourg, Switzerland.

10. Final Provisions

By paying the participation fee, the participant confirms acceptance of these Terms and Conditions and agrees to comply with the rules and spirit of the Event.
